What we seek: The Food Project – Lincoln, is seeking 10 agriculture Interns to work at our Lincoln farm site. Within the Agriculture Internship there will be two harvest groups

- On Farm CSA (5 Interns): Interns will assist in the harvesting, distribution, setup and cleanup of the on farm Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program.
- Delivery CSA (5 Interns): Interns will assist in the harvesting, washing, packing and distribution of produce for our delivery CSA

Specific duties:

All Lincoln Interns will assist in all areas of farm work, including but not limited to farm preparation, planting, seeding, weeding, harvesting, special agriculture projects and other farm related tasks.

Interns will gain customer service and marketing skills through assisting CSA members with their vegetable pick up and farm experience.

Interns will facilitate groups through being strong role models for the Summer Youth Program, DIRT and volunteers. A primary responsibility will be to model hard work and enthusiasm for the Summer Youth Program participants and also professionalism when dealing with CSA customers.

This is an advanced internship, geared towards youth with a strong agricultural interest. An advanced agricultural curriculum will be included in the work hours, and youth can expect to play a more serious role in the planning and management of our land.

Interns will report primarily to the Assistant Grower and secondarily to the Rural Grower, CSA Supervisor, and Assistant Farm Manager. Interns will participate in regular feedback sessions with Assistant Grower and meet all the expectations as outlined in The Internship Manual regarding standards, office norms and task completion.

Lincoln Intern Schedule:

All Lincoln Interns will work approximately from June 28th – August 20th. Hours of the Lincoln Internship are Monday-Friday 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM. Two Interns are asked to work from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM on Tuesday and Thursday.
