## Work Share Program

**What:** The Work Share program is a volunteer opportunity to assist in farm work at our farms in Lynn, Wenham, and Lincoln in return for fresh vegetables from the farm during the academic year. The farm tasks include harvesting, weeding, bed preparation, planting, washing, and volunteer group check ins. This is a great opportunity for someone who is interested in working outside and contributing to the Food Project’s vision and mission. We ask that **volunteers commit to one 3-hour volunteer session a week at a minimum.** Start and end dates are flexible.

**Who:** Anyone in the community who is interested in agriculture and is physically able to work outside in all weather conditions.
